The selection process for King and Queen is based upon leadership activities and campus involvement. An essay **must** be provided as part of the application process. All applications **must** be submitted to Student Engagement and Leadership (Mountainlair 162) **by Wednesday, September 12, 2018 by 12:00 PM (Noon). No exceptions will be made.**

The application essay should be one (1) to two (2), pages addressing the following prompt:

Essay: Explain what qualifies you to represent WVU as Homecoming King or Queen

All Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Minimum overall grade point average of 2.5 and be enrolled as a full-time student at West Virginia University, Morgantown campus.
- Completed 89 credit-hours prior to the start of the Fall 2018 semester
- Must not have been a Homecoming Court member in the past
- Completed the Application:
 - Essay
 - Information Form
 - Campus Involvement Summary
 - Bio Info Sheet

Upon evaluation of your application by our Homecoming Court judges, the top candidates will be invited to the interview phase of the selection process. If selected, a five (5) to eight (8) person panel will conduct interviews on Monday, September 24th in the Mountainlair starting at 5:00 PM.
